


**SIGN TYPE #10  
INFORMATION SIGNS AT A SERVICE STATION  
LOCATED IN A RESIDENTIAL VILLAGE**



- Sign purpose: Permanent sign at a service station fuel pump, located in a residential village.
- Sign use: To indicate oil company name and/or symbol, number of the pump, the grade of fuel, whether the pump is for self service or full service, and to provide safety information.
- Sign location: At fuel pump. Not attached to canopy columns.
- Maximum number: One per side of pump for each item listed above under "sign use."
- Maximum sign size: 5 inches high
- Maximum sign height: 5 inches high
- Sign copy: Only oil company name and/or symbol, number of the pump, the grade of fuel, whether the pump is for self service or full service, and to provide safety information. Signs advertising items or services for sale are prohibited. Signs advertising the name of the proprietor are prohibited.
- Maximum character height: 5 inches
- Sign material: Vinyl.
- Sign illumination: None.
- Permit required? No.

The following signs are not allowed at service stations: banners; pennants, except for Sign Type #40 as approved by the Director of Community Development; flags; portable signs; signs attached to light poles, planters, waste receptacles, and telephone booths; and advertising video displays.
