
Parking information, such as, but not limited to, "deliveries," "exit," address numbers, and street names. Sign copy:

Up to 12 inches high with a 2-inch margin of blank space between sign copy and edge of sign panel. Maximum character size:

Sign material: Plastic is permitted for sign copy. Plastic is prohibited for sign background. Posts must be square metal posts (such as tubular aluminum), painted, without continuous pre-punched holes. Wood, steel and prepunched galvanized channels are not acceptable.

External, low-profile, floodlighting is permitted. Internal-illumination of sign copy is permitted. Internal-illumination of sign background is prohibited. Exposed neon is prohibited. Sign illumination:
