


**SIGN TYPE #28
MENU BOARDS**



- Sign purpose: Permanent ground sign which provide information regarding product pricing at drive-through lanes.
- Sign use: Single-sided sign used only for menu identification for drivers in drive-thru lane, not for off-site business identification or advertising.
- Sign location: On private property.
Outside of sight distance triangle.
Behind perimeter hedge, berm, or screen wall.
Text not visible from the public right-of-way
- Landscaping: Landscape screening is required between the sign and the public street.
- Maximum number: Two signs per drive-thru lane.
- Maximum sign size: 7 feet high above grade at midpoint of sign.
8 feet wide.
Up to 56 square feet.
- Sign copy: Only menu information. Brand names and information which makes the sign appear to be advertisement, such as ® and TM, are prohibited.
- Maximum character size: Up to 4 inches high for letters, numbers, and letterforms; with a 2 inch margin of blank space between sign copy and edge of sign panel.
- Sign material: Plastic is permitted for sign copy only, not for sign background.
- Sign design: Pole signs (i.e. panels mounted on exposed posts) are not allowed. Permanent and temporary signs attached to the menu board are not permitted.
- Sign illumination: External, low-profile, floodlighting is permitted. Internal-illumination of sign copy is permitted. Internal-illumination of sign background is prohibited. Exposed neon is prohibited. Exposed raceways are prohibited.
